

Rounds Lectures are presented by the Tufts University School of Dental Medicine Craniofacial Pain Center in collaboration with Massachusetts General Hospital, Harvard Medical School, and Harvard School of Dental Medicine. Multiple orofacial pain training programs now participate in the Saturday morning Case Studies & Literature Reviews and CE is available for dental professionals.
